What am I covered for:	<p>Accidental Death - We will pay the Principal Sum shown in the Policy Schedule if Injury to You results in loss of life. The loss must occur under the circumstances described in a Hazard within 365 Days from the date of the Accident which caused Injury.</p> <p>Fractures / Dislocation / Burns - We will pay a percentage of the Principal Sum shown in the Policy Schedule if Injury to You results in one of the losses shown in the Schedule of Injuries. The Injury must occur during the circumstances described in Hazard H-1 within 90 Days from the date of the Accident, which caused Injury.</p> <p>Hospital Indemnity Accident Only - We will pay a Daily Benefit for each Day You are an Inpatient in a Hospital due to Injury subject to any applicable Deductible or Franchise shown in the Policy Schedule, that occurs anywhere in the world and commences during the circumstances described in Hazard H-1 and while this Policy is in effect.</p> <p>Loss of Activities of Daily Living - When as the result of Injury occurring under the circumstances described in Hazard H-1 and commencing within 365 Days from the date of the Accident You suffer a Permanent inability to perform 3 or more Activities of Daily Living as defined in this Policy for a continuous period of 180 Days.
